CONDITIONS OF PLAY

1. All matches will be played under the Rules and Regulations of the N.Z. Table Tennis Association.
2. Ball: The Villa xx Ball will be used for all matches.
3. Dress: Players must wear Grey or Dark Clothing in all Matches; tennis shoes must be worn.
4. The draw will be seeded to prevent as far as possible players from the same Association meeting in early rounds.
5. Referee will be appointed each day, his decision in any dispute is final.
6. Competitors must be prepared to umpire when called upon.
7. Competitors must report to official in charge on arrival each day.
8. Amount of back play is 30 feet.
9. **Matches commence at 7 p.m. each day.**
10. The Committee reserve the right to scratch any player who does not conform to any of the above.
11. Juniors may elect to play in either senior or junior singles, but not in both.
12. Entries must reach the Secretary, with fees, by 12 noon, Saturday 12th August, 1939, otherwise entry will not be accepted.
13. All entries and fees must come from the Secretary of the Association, not from individuals.
