## CONDITIONS OF PLAY.

1. All matches will be played under the Rules of the New Zealand Table Tennis Association.
2. Ball: The Villa xx Ball will be used for all matches.
3. Dress: Players must wear Grey or Dark Clothing in all matches; tennis shoes must be worn. The Committee reserves the right to scratch any player who does not conform to this rule regarding dress.
4. The Committee reserves the right to seed the draw.
5. The referee's decision in any dispute on a point of law is final. The decision of the umpire on a point of fact is final.
6. Competitors must report to official in charge on arrival.
7. Amount of back play is 10 feet.
8. Matches commence at 1 p.m. The Committee reserves the right to scratch any player who arrives late.
9. Entries must reach the Hon. Secretary (R. W. Owen, P.O. Box 21, Stratford) WITH FEES, by 8 p.m. SATURDAY, 31st August, 1940, OTHERWISE ENTRY WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.
10. Men's Singles and Doubles events will be best of 5 advantage sets of 21 points up; all other events will be best of 3 advantage sets of 21 points up.
