CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. All matches will be played under the Rules of Table Tennis as adopted by the N.Z.T.T.A., whose authority has been obtained to conduct this tournament.
2. Play will commence at 9 a.m. and continue until the tournament is completed. (Light meals will be available at the Hall throughout the day.)
3. Barna 3 Crown Balls will be used.
4. At least 6 tables will be in use and each table will have a run back of 15 ft. and side play of 9 ft.
5. Senior Games will be the best of 5 advantage games and Junior Games the best of 3 advantage games.
6. All competitors must wear dark coloured clothing while playing and white soled sandshoes.
7. Control of play will be by Call Board and Table Stewards and the fact that a player's name has been posted on the Call Board shall be deemed to constitute adequate notice of an impending match. Failure of any player to answer such call within 5 minutes shall render that player liable to disqualification. **FIRST ROUND MATCHES WILL BE SHOWN AT 9 A.M.**
8. All contestants will find their own umpires.
9. An umpire's decision on a point of fact shall be final. The Referee's decision on a point of law shall be final.
10. The Committee will seed the draw.
11. Any player who wishes to enter for a Doubles event but has no partner may do so and the Committee will endeavour to provide a partner.
12. Competitors in events Nos. 6 and 7 must be under the age of 18 years at 30/4/66.
