CONDITIONS OF PLAY

All matches will be played under the Rules of the New Zealand Table Tennis Association (Inc).

The Dunlop-Barna 3-crown ball will be used in all matches.

DRESS. Players shall not wear white or light coloured clothing which might tend to unsight an opponent. (It is fairly certain that such colours as pale pink, pale lemon, pale blue and very light grey will be considered as being light-coloured clothing) Tennis shoes must be worn. The Tournament Manager reserves the right to scratch any player who does not conform to these requirements.

The Committee reserves the right to seed the draw.

All Open Championship Events shall be the best of five advantage sets of 21 points up. All Junior events shall be the best of three advantage sets of 21 points up.

The pushing play Time-limit Regulations will be enforced.

Play shall be continuous from the first service until the match be concluded, provided that when necessitated by circumstances not within the control of the players the Umpire may suspend play for such period as he may consider necessary. Play shall never be suspended for the purpose of allowing a player to recover his strength or wind. The Umpire shall be sole judge of intentional delay, and after giving warning, he may disqualify the offender.

The Referee's decision in any dispute on a point of law is final. The decision of the Umpire on a point of fact is final.

The Tournament is under the control of the Tournament Manager.

The Referee is Mr. D. Williams.

The new laws banning sponge bats and bats with yellow rubber facings will be enforced.

Matches will commence at 9.00 a.m. unless advised otherwise. The Tournament Manager reserves the right to scratch any player who arrives late or who is absent when called upon to play. (THIS RULE WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED)
