CONDITIONS OF PLAY

1. All matches will be played under the Rules of the New Zealand Table Tennis Association.
2. BALL: The 3-star will be used for all matches.
3. DRESS: Players must wear dark clothing in all matches, tennis shoes must also be worn. The Committee reserves the right to scratch any player who does not conform to this rule regarding dress.
4. BATS: Only racket cover colouring of dark red, dark blue, dark green, dark brown and black are permitted and rackets must be of the same colour on both sides.
5. The Committee reserves the right to seed the draw.
6. The referee's decision in any dispute on a point of law is final. The decision of the umpire on a point of fact is final.
7. Competitors must report to official in charge on arrival at Hall.
8. Amount of back play will be at least 10 feet.
9. HOURS OF PLAY: Commencing 9.00 a.m. with the Combined Doubles. All Competitors in this event must have checked in by 9.00 a.m. All other Competitors must check in by 9.30 a.m. **The Committee reserves the right to scratch any player arriving late or any player who is not available when required.**
10. Entries must reach the Secretary (Mrs V. Taylor, 61 Browns Road, Manurewa), accompanied by fees, by TUESDAY, 24th MARCH, 1970, at 5 p.m.
11. Events Nos. 1 to 5 will be the best of five advantage games of 21 points. All other events will be the best of three advantage games of 21 points.
12. Play shall be continuous from the first service until the match be concluded, provided that when when necessitated by circumstances not within the control of the players. The Umpire may suspend play for such period as he may consider necessary. Play shall never be suspended for the purpose of allowing a player to recover his strength or his wind. The Umpire shall be the sole judge of intentional delay and after giving due warning he may disqualify the offender.
13. The first-named player on the board will be responsible for getting an umpire.
14. The Service Rule will be strictly adhered to.
15. The Expedite will be enforced.
16. Refreshments available at the Hall.
17. If the tournament is over by 11 p.m. a social will be held.
