MISS KIMIYO MATSUZAKI

Born in June, 1938, Miss Matsuzaki is a University Student at the Senshu University. She gained the World Ladies' Singles title at Dortmund in 1959, when she defeated F. Eguchi the titleholder. Miss Matsuzaki a round-faced ball of energy has the following titles to her credit:—

- 1958—Singles Champion of all Japan
- 1958—Singles Champion of all Japan Colleges
- 1959—Singles Champion of all Japan
- 1959—World Ladies' Singles Champion.

MISS KAZUKO YAMAIZUMI

Is a staff member, Toyo Laiyon K.K. In the final of the 1959 World Doubles Championship, Miss Yamaizumi and her partner T. Ramba defeated Miss Matsuzaki and Eguchi in straight sets which is quite a feat, both opponents having held the World Ladies' Singles title. 25 years old Miss Yamaizumi has rather an impressive list of titles:—

- 1957—Singles Champion of all Japan.
- 1958—3rd Ranking in all Japan National Championships.
- 1959—Co-holder World Ladies' Doubles Championships.
- 1959—Champion Tokyo Championships for Singles, Doubles and Mixed Doubles.

Not long out of the Juniors are both very keen and have represented Waikato on many occasions.

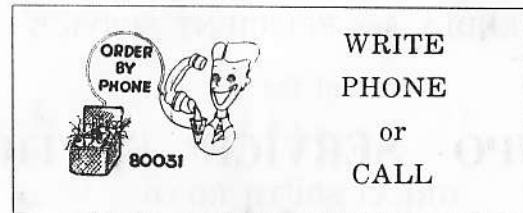
MISS JEANETTE BRIDSON
