



GAVIN SHEWAN

Gavin has been a top grade player in Hamilton since 1953 and has represented both Hamilton and Waikato continuously since then. He has won the Hamilton Singles Title 9 times in 11 years and the Waikato Singles 3 times. His list of titles includes the Bay of Plenty Open in 1959. He plays an attacking game and has a good defence.

TERRY COCKFIELD

Terry has been in Hamilton only two years but has proved his merit by winning the Hamilton Singles and top ranking last season. Previous to that he had gained his 'Varsity Blue after winning the New Zealand University Singles Title four years in a row as well as numerous Doubles Titles. He represented Auckland in 1960. He won the Northland Junior Singles and represented that Association in 1955 and the following year also won the North Taranaki and Manawatu Junior titles. He favours a defensive game but hits hard when the opportunity arises.

TOM PICKERING

Tom was top Waikato Junior in 1955 and represented that Association in 1959 and 1962. Between those years he was at Massey College and represented Manawatu several times. He is now a member of Hamilton's senior team and has started off this season winning the Central Waikato Open Singles. Prefers to attack on both wings but can defend if necessary.

ROBIN RADFORD

After playing for Canterbury for two seasons and winning the South Canterbury Open Singles, Robin came from Christchurch seven years ago. He has represented Waikato on numerous occasions and has done stirling work as Secretary of both Waikato and Hamilton.

JOHN DUNN

John has been an outstanding figure in Hamilton Table Tennis. As a Junior, he won the Waikato Junior Singles. In 1959, he highlighted his career to date by winning the N.Z. under 18 Singles from a strong field. He won the Waikato Singles three years in succession and also the North Taranaki Open Singles. He has a particularly accurate defence but attacks when necessary.
