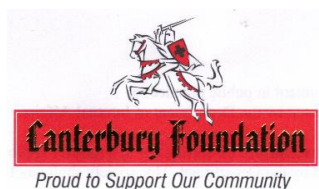

# CONDITIONS

## EQUIPMENT

- Tables: Blue Butterfly, Donic, Stiga
- Nets: Blue
- Ball: Butterfly 3 star (orange) 40 mm

## ELIGIBILITY

- Only registered members of TTNZ and players affiliated to ITTF member countries are eligible. TTNZ members must quote their membership number on their entry form.
- Age category eligibility is determined by age as at 31.12.03. Proof of age may be required.

## ENTRIES

- Envelopes containing entries must be postmarked no later than the closing date and arrive at TTNZ no later than 7 days after the closing date.
- Entries must be accompanied by the correct fees. TTNZ reserves the right to impose a penalty for late payments. Fees are refundable if advice of a withdrawal is received by TTNZ within 14 days of the closing date.
- No player may enter more than two age categories which shall be consecutive.
- TTNZ reserves the right to refuse any entry and to vary restrictions at its discretion.
- Both players in any doubles pairing must submit separate individual entries for the same doubles event.
- Any entrant wishing to receive acknowledgement of receipt of their entry form must enclose a stamped self-addressed envelope. Otherwise entries will be processed without acknowledgement.

## DRAWS

- For singles events section play shall be conducted on a round robin basis, followed by post-section knock-out play to which some players may be granted direct entry. Full singles play guidelines are contained in Section 4 of the Table Tennis New Zealand Handbook which can be viewed on the TTNZ web site.
- For doubles events seeded knock-out draws shall be conducted except where less than 6 pairs have entered. The round-robin format may then be used.
- Any event with less than 4 singles entries or 3 doubles pairs may be cancelled at the discretion of TTNZ. Players so affected will be entered in the next lower age category if they are not already in that category.
- The right is reserved to make alterations to any draw.

## MATCHES

- All matches shall be best of five advantage games to 11.

## TEAM EVENTS

- A separate team entry form has been sent to all Associations. If an Association does not submit a team entry form, individual players from that Association may apply for a position in either one or two teams made up from a draft pool (if two, they must be in consecutive age categories) by completing the appropriate section of the individual entry form and paying the required fee. All applications will be considered by TTNZ, whose decision on the make-up of all composite teams will be final. TTNZ will also decide under which Association's name each draft team will play under. If two players from the same Association apply for a place in a draft team in the same age category, they will be paired together and play under the name of their Association.

## DRUGS

- The New Zealand Sports Drug Agency reserves the right to conduct random drug testing.

## GLUING

- No gluing shall be permitted inside the stadium other than within areas designated for the purpose.

## AUTHORITY

- The Tournament Manager reserves the right to vary these conditions, with the agreement of the TTNZ Liaison Officer, and to exercise control over all activities within the stadium and adjacent areas. This includes the right to default players who fail to respond when called to the table within the published or announced playing session times.
- The Referee and delegated assistants reserve the right to apply and enforce the Laws and International Regulations of Table Tennis as adopted by the ITTF and TTNZ. Their interpretation of these laws and regulations is final.
