

1994 WORLD VETERANS

Bulletin No.4 has not yet arrived so I couldn't wait any longer to get this Newsletter out. However, I do have quite a lot of extra information for you some of which needs urgent attention.

ENTRIES

They close on 10 February,1994 and any late entries accepted will be charged an extra \$20 Aust. They will not accept personal cheques unless you have an Australian $\overline{\text{Bank}}$ Account. So it is essential when you Register to go to your Bank and get them to have a cheque made out in Australian Dollars.

ACCOMMODATION

Those who have booked accommodation through me will have it confirmed separately with the amount of the deposit to send to me which I have already paid on your behalf. The only space left at present is for one male in a 2 bedroom unit with 3 others. Anybody wanting to fill that gap let me know as soon as possible. If anybody else needs accommodation let me know soon as I may be able to get extra units at the Royal Gardens Motel which is only 100 metres from the Stadium.



TRAVEL TO TOURNAMENTS

Air New Zealand and Ansett have made special fares available on some flights from 19 February to 30 June with bookings having to be made by 6 March. The New Zealand Veterans and the South Island Championships are in this time slot so if you wan't to go to either of them get in quick.

THELMA MAY QSM

Thelma May who was Canterbury's leading woman Table Tennis player for many years passed away in Christchurch on 20 February after a long and painful illness at the age of 64. She started playing in Christchurch in 1947 and through her playing career represented Canterbury over 300 times which may well be a New Zealand record. Thelma won the NZ Womens Doubles title in 1964 with Val Braumann and was a dominant force in the South Island for many years winning a large number of titles. When she became a Veteran she continued her winning way with many titles at Provincial and National levels. She had a number of successful trips to the Australian Veterans from when they commenced in 1984 and has won many Medals at the New Zealand Veterans from its commencement in 1987. In 1958, 1964 and 1972 she was in the Canterbury Team that won the Teagle Shield and in 1967 she beat the National Womens Champion, Dawn Wade, in a Teagle Shield match as a result of which she was named "Canterbury Player of the Year". Thelma also worked hard in Table Tennis Administration. served for 22 years on the Canterbury Association Executive Committee and in 1973 was made a Life Member. In 1976 she was elected the first woman Vice-President of the New Zealand Association. She also held the position of South Island Selector in the late 1970's and was on the National Selectors Panel. She was still a Canterbury Selector and a Committee Member at the time of her death. In 1977 she went to the Commonwealth Championships in Guernsey and in the same year played in the World Championships in England. In 1981 she went to Germany as Coach of the New Zealand Deaf Team and has assisted in a number of New Zealand Deaf Tournaments. In 1987 Thelma was awarded the Queens Service Medal for services to Table Tennis which was well deserved for her years of voluntary work. Thelma will be sadly missed, especially by our Veterans, but her

daughter Sandra, while not up to her Mum's standard, is determined to continue in our favourite sport.

1994 NEW ZEALAND MASTERS GAMES

The ITTF has once again changed its mind on the Glueing of Bats and deferred the banning of legal glues until August 1995. At the next National Council Meeting this matter will be discussed and it is likely that the rule won't apply to New Zealand until January, 1996.

Trialling of up to 11 instead of up to 21 and the service having to be in front of the body has been strongly opposed by a number of Associations and players and will be discussed at the National Council Meeting on 20 March, it is possible that the previous decision may be over ruled and trials will not take place at the Norths, Souths and Nationals.

1994 WORLD VETERANS

About 60 players from New Zealand played in the 1994 World Veterans held in Melbourne from 22-27 April. With over 1800 Entries from 50 Countries it was the biggest ever Tournament and was played on 66 Tables with quite a few extra tables for practise. All our players enjoyed the opportunity to meet and play people from all round the World and to see ex World Champions still going strong as Veterans. With so many entries it was not possible for the Officials to have any idea of the standard of most players so the round robin groups varied from very strong to very weak so it wasn't always the best players who made the main draw. The number of entries in the Age Groups varied considerably with the Over 50 Men at 436 well above the others. 0.40 Men 280; 0.40 Women 136; 0.50 Men 436; 0.50 Women 296; 0.60 Men 324; 0.60 Women 140; 0.70 Men 132; 0.70 Women 56; 0.80 Men 21; 0.80 Women 9; Total 1830. The following 25 New Zealand players made the main draw from the Singles Groups: Over 40 Men B. Connolly, R. Lee, K. Fogarty, P. Bennett, J.Morris. Over 40 Women Y.Fogarty, V.Beaver, V.Scarr. Over 50 Men R. Dunn, J. Williams. Over 50 Women J. Stead, K. Thompson, M. McAvinue, N. Garrett, P. Bennyworth. Over 60 Men A. Tomlinson, J. Lelliott, J. Coad, B. Stephens, R. Johnstone, W. Joker. Over 60 Women B. Jackson. Over 70 Women I.Cleland, A.Stevenson. Over 80 Men A. Harding. A number went on to win knock out matches with the best performance by Yvonne Fogarty who made the last 8 in the Over 40 Women in a very strong field and lost to K. Harada from Japan. Isabel Cleland made the last 8 in the Over 70 Women and Barbara Jackson the last 16 in the Over 60 Women (she doesn't turn 60 until September). In the Consolation events William Weinstock did well to finish runner up in the Over 40 Men and Merle Harding got a lovely small Trophy for winning the Over 80 Women with Kath Grinstead the runner-up. Alf Harding did well to win a Bronze Medal in the Over 80 Doubles with W.Henry(Aust). They lost in the semi-final to S.Wynack(Aust) & V.Noberg(Den) 17-21 21-16 21-12. The outstanding player in the Tournament was clearly G.L.Liang the Chinese ex World Champion who won the Over 40 Mens Singles and Doubles. Another famous name, D. Surbek, currently ranked in the top 100 in the World(above Peter Jackson) didn't do as well not even making the Over 40 Quarter Finals. I still haven't received the replt sheets from Australia so I can only give you the Singles Finals results which I recorded. 
