PROMOTION OF VETERANS AND MASTERS SPORTS

The Hillary Commission is devoting a lot of time to the promotion of Veterans and Masters Sports in conjunction with the Regional Sports Trusts. All Associations should have recently received a form to fill in full details of Veterans and Masters Table Tennis in their areas. It would be appreciated if a member from each Association could follow this matter up and ensure the form is completed and returned to the Hillary Commission by 2nd June. This is a very important matter as Table Tennis New Zealand would struggle to survive without the support of the Hillary Commission.

MAJOR TOURNAMENTS

The South Island Championships will be held in Timaru from 16-18 June. Entries close on Wednesday 24 May.

The North Island Championships are in Auckland from 7-9 July with entries closing on Tuesday 6 June.

The National Championships will be held in Whangarei with the Seniors from 29 August to 2 September. As there are no Over 40 Teams the Over 35's, 45's and 55's individual events are expected to start on 31 August. The latest information is that there could be a number of Overseas players this year with 20 from a Japanese Club. The Mens and Womens Open Singles Winners (Peter Jackson and Li Chun Li ?) will both get \$1,000 Prize Money.







1995 AUSTRALIAN VETERANS CHAMPIONSHIPS
Entry Forms are now available with the closing date 1 September.
Forms will be sent to members who have indicated they are going and anybody with a last minute interest please contact me as soon as possible so that I can send you a Form and get you in a Team. Please return the Forms to me no later than 15 August as they have to be sent through the New Zealand Association. It is not necessary to send the Entry Fee as the NZTTA will pay and everybody will then be sent an invoice covering all costs including Team Entry Fees converted to New Zealand Dollars. There have been no changes and as previously advised it will be held in Melbourne from 14-21 October.

AGE GROUPS IN MAJOR TOURNAMENTS

Due to the new rule at the South and North Island Championships that players may not enter both Over 35's and Over 40's there were very few entries in the Over 35's. This new rule meant that that long time Veterans in their late 40's could only enter one Age Group. To overcome this problem I think that we should change the Age Groups for the North's and South's to Over 35's, Over 45's, Over 55's and Over 65's. With our ageing population something like this will be necessary in the future so if any of you have any comments I would like to hear from you so that I can pass on your views to the National Council and/or the Convenor of the New Zealand Tournament Committee.

I wouldn't recommend an Age Group shown on the Semaphore Board at the North Island Championships - Christine Cunningham Vs Sue Shirrefs - OVER 17 Womens Singles.

RAY ROWLAND

Further to the Photograph and Background to our old friend Ray Rowland on the Cover Sheet the following details has been provided by the Manawatu Association.

Excerpt from a 1982 Souvenir Programme (Written by Bob Perks): "Ray Rowland, Age "Just as Young as Ever", commenced his playing career in 1929, his bat a cut-out piece of timber from a petrol box and he has played ever since. During the War Years he even played in the Force's Teams just to keep his hand in. Today (1982) he still plays in our A Reserve Grade, a terror to up-and-coming Juniors and after 55 years still going strong. Well done Ray may you play for many years to come."
1932 - Member of the Tiakitahuna Club affiliated to the newly

formed Manawatu Association. 1936-1940 - Represented Manawatu and played for the Terrace End Club.

1936,37 and 39 - Mens Doubles Champ at the Manawatu Closed. 1940 - Mens Singles and Mixed Doubles Champion at Manawatu Closed.

1961 - 1969 - Ray was President of the Manawatu Association.

1972 - His contribution to Table Tennis recognised by being made

a Life Member of the Manawatu Association. 1979 - He very generously sponsored the Manawatu Open to celebrate his 50 years of continuous playing.

1982 - Member of the Manawatu Golden Jubilee Committee.

1988 -1990 - Won 4 Gold Medals at the Australian Veterans.

Ray was also a J.P. and of course took on these time consuming duties with a lot of thought and care in his usual competent manner.

Best wishes to you all for the rest of the Season and I look forward to meeting some of you at Whangarei in late August.


