FRANK (FRANCIS JOSEPH) O'GORMAN

Frank O'Gorman a well known South Canterbury Table Tennis stalwart passed away in Timaru on Tuesday 10th February at the age of 76.

Frank will be sadly missed in Table Tennis particularly by the Veterans. He was not only a good player both in his younger days and has a Veteran but also a good administrator with a special strength in Publicity where he operated under the name of CHOP SMASH. He always seemed to be able to persuade the papers to print the information that he provided. Frank devoted most of his spare time to Table Tennis which was rewarded in 1974 when he was made a Life Member of the New Zealand Table Tennis Assn. He served on the New Zealand Executive Committee and was among the few who were prepared to speak up and express his personal opinion on matters at the National level. Frank was a honest



outspoken person and most of us would have held him in high regard.

Some of the Australian Veterans will remember him as he took part in the 1st Australian Veterans Championships in Hobart in 1984.

In 1993 he was lucky to survive being rescued from a big fire in the Seaview Hotel, Timaru which was his home at the time. Frank also had an interest in Bowls and Tennis and in his younger days in 1939 and 1940 he was the South Canterbury Junior Sprint Champion. During the Second World War he served for 4 years in the Royal New Zealand Air Force clerical division. Frank hasn't been able to play for several years because his eyesight deteriorated to the extent that he was hardly able to see the Ball.

Frank was never married so he didn't have any family who we can share his sad loss with but he will be remembered for ever by his old Table Tennis friends.
