The eligibility Age is as at 31st October, 1998.

WORLD VETERANS CHAMPIONSHIPS

The World Veterans Championships were held in Manchester, England in late June. As usual with Veterans Events the atmosphere was first class throughout the Tournament and the Venue was very good with over 80 Tables.

Nine players from New Zealand attended, all from the Lower North Island, although one didn't participate. They were Bruce & Margaret Connolly, John Lelliott (Hutt Valley); Les & Paddy Field, Val Scarr (Wairarapa); Jim Jarmin, Shona Mudgeway, (Manawatu), Evan Williams (Wanganui).

In the Singles and Doubles there were Groups of 4 who played Round-Robins with the top 2 going through to the Main Draw and the bottom 2 to the Consolation Draw.

In the Over 50 mens Singles Bruce Connolly came 2nd in his Group but lost his first Match in the Main Draw. Les Field came 4th in his Group and lost his first Match in the Consolation.

In the Over 60 Men Jim Jarmin and Evan Williams both came 4th in their Groups, Jim Jarmin won his first 2 Matches in the Consolation but lost in the 3rd; Evan Williams won Round One but was beaten in Round Two. In the Over 70 Mens Singles

John Lelliott won his Group and then won the first 3 Rounds in the Main Draw but was beaten in the Quarter Final by the eventual Winner, Ron Etheridge of England, 21-19 22-20, a good performance to finish in the top 8 in the World despite a problem with his knee caused by an inflammation on the Plane.

In the Over 50 Womens Singles Val Scarr came 2nd in her Group and then progressed to the last 32 by winning Rounds 1 and 2. Margaret Connolly and Paddy Field both came 4th in their Groups and both lost in the 1st Round of the Consolation.

In the Doubles Bruce Connolly with Les Field and Jim Jarmin with Evan Williams lost all of their Matches. John Lelliott partnered by F. Chew from Malaysia came 2nd in Group Play but lost in the 1st Round of the Main Draw. In the Over 40 Womens Doubles Val Scarr partnered by the very young N. Baibulatova from Russia came 3rd in their Group but played well in the Consolation Draw to get to the Final where they lost to a Japanese pair 21-15 21-14. Margaret Connolly with Paddy Field came 4th in their Group but had a win in the 1st Round of the Consolation.

Entries were good as follows:- 0.40 Men 250; 0.40 Women 80; 0.50 Men 264; 0.50 Women 140; 0.60 Men 304; Over 60 Women 128; 0.70 Men 108; 0.70 Women 50; 0.80 Men 16; 0.80 Women 11.

The next World Veterans will be held in Vancouver, Canada in late May in the Year 2,000.

I'm sorry that this Newsletter is a few weeks later than usual but all the catch up work I've had to do since returning from the World Veterans as slowed things down.

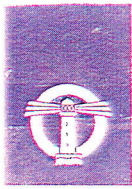
TTNZ INDIVIDUAL MEMBER REGISTRATION

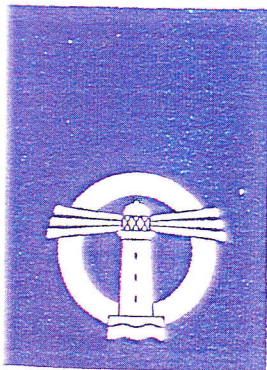

Nine players from New Zealand competed in the Australian Veterans Championships held in Hobart from 17th to 24th October. The Over 40 Womens Team of Val Beaver, Lynley Barker and Averil Roberts finished 3rd winning 5 of their 8 matches. Val Beaver played well winning 18 of her 24 matches which was a good 75%, Averil won 54% and Lynley 46%.

The Over 40 Mens Team of Doug Pattinson, John Fogarty, Kevin Fogarty and Chip Eade won 4 of their 9 matches and finished 6th out of 10 Teams. Doug Pattinson did well in a very strong field to win 61%, John Fogarty won 46%, Kevin won 35% and Chip won 20%. John Fogarty has improved a lot and upset Igor Klaf, the current Over 40 New Zealand Champion 21-19 in the third. John Lelliott played in an Over 60 Presidents Team which finished 7th out of 9 Teams and won 67% of his matches.
