INTERNATIONAL RULES

Bad news for Mike McAvinue, the latest rule change doesn't allow Umpires at the World Chambionships to be over 60. I'm sure, however, that he can make good use of his International Umpires Badge for the first half of the 1990's.

Another change is an increase in the minimum light level from 400 to 1,000 Lux. I hope we can ignore the new rule in New Zealand otherwise we would have to paint the ball black for Tournaments that have fluorescent lighting up to that level.

The tentative programme is to open up at 8.30 a.m. on Friday Morning 29 March with tables available for practise. The Teams Events are expected to commence about 10.30 a.m. and continue through on Saturday. On FRiday evening there will be a Reception/Social Evening with the official opening by the Mayor.

The individual events may commence on Saturday, depending on when the Teams Events finish, and will be played through on Sunday and Monday.

On Monday Evening there will be a Dinner Dance with all of the presentations at the Flemington Racecourse.

There is plenty of good accommodation within walking distance of the Stadium and following negotiations, on possible discounts, full details will be made available in plenty of time for you to make your bookings.

1990 AUSTRALIAN VETERANS TABLE TENNIS CHAMPIONSHIPS

The smallest number ever from New Zealand participated in the 7th Australian Veterans Championships held at Hobart from 20 to 27 October. With John Lelliott having to withdraw at the last minute due to a calf muscle injury Eddie Millard (only 50) had to join Pat Doyle and Danny Krul in the Over 60 Mens Team. The only others were the Over 70 Mens Team of Valley Kwok and Ray Rowland who performed very well. They beat New South Wales 4-1, Tasmania 4-1 and in the key match beat Victoria 3-2 with Valley beating the Over 70 Singles Champion, Stan Wynack, 21-16 21-12 and going through the Teams matches unbeaten. While a New Zealand Team can't be the official winners their win was recognised by Ray and Valley each receiving a Statuette of a Table Tennis Player, suitably inscribed, for their 'Peritorious Performance'. The Over 60 Team didn't do so well as they lost their five matches and finished sixth.

In the individual events Valley and Ray both won a Gold and a Silver Medal. They won the Over 70 Mens Doubles beating Wynack and Huysmans 21-17 22-20 in the Final. Valley lost to Wynack in the Over 70 Mens Singles 21-19 14-21 16-21 and Ray partnered by Pat Beard was runner-up in the Over 70 Mixed Doubles to Wynak and M.Gleeson.

In the Merit List Valley Kwok was No.2 and Ray Rowland No.5 in the Over 70 Men.

I'm told they all enjoyed the trip and our congratulations to Valley and Ray for a very good performance.

A list of the Finals results for all individual events is attached as it may be of some interest to those who have been to the Australian Veterans in recent years.

They will be held next year in Brisbane and there will also be an Australian Masters run in conjunction with it. The dates have not been finalised but it is anticipated that they will be held between 12th and 19th October.

1991 Australian Veterans Championships and Masters Games

These two events will be run together over a week from Saturday 12 October to Friday 18 October. It appears that the only activity on the first day will be the welcome evening but from then on it will be all go from Sunday morning to Friday evening followed by a Farewell and Presentation evening on Saturday 19 October.

Venue: Brisbane Table Tennis Stadium, Downey Park, Windsor.

Tentative Programmes:

<u>Veterans</u>: - Sunday 13th - Teams all day.

Mon., Tues., Wed. 14th-16th - Teams Morning and Afternoon.

Thurs., Friday 17th & 18th - Individual Events.

Masters Games: - Monday & Tuesday Evenings 14th & 15th - Singles. Wednesday 16th Evening - Doubles.

Entries:

 $\underline{\text{Veterans}}$: A player may be entered in only one team but may enter any individual events for which eligible.

<u>Masters</u>: All players are restricted to one singles and one doubles. <u>Eligibility</u>: A player is eligible for an age group if that age is reached at any time during the 1991 Year. For example turn 40 on 25/12/91 and you can enter Over 40's even though you are still 39.

Accommodation: It is essential that accommodation be booked as soon as possible as there are over 30 sports competing in the Masters Games. In the circumstances it would be appreciated if you would let me know as soon as possible if you intend to enter so that a block booking can be made by about mid-April. I will also ensure that those interested get entry forms for both events and that your names are submitted for the teams.

Membership for 1991

It is intended to continue the Newsletters for 1991 but the annual subscription will be \$3 which will meet this years costs and make up last years deficit. The small number who didn't pay last year will need to pay \$5 if they are to continue receiving the Newsletters.
